BETTER BROADBAND FOR NOTTINGHAMSHIRE

This project, alongside the work of commercial companies, aims to provide 94% of Nottinghamshire with a faster fibre-based broadband network (ie speeds of 24MBps) by the end of 2016. Carlton on Trent is currently scheduled to get faster broadband by the end of 2014.

This involves installing new cabinets at or near the location of the existing BT boxes in the village. There is no consultation on this as planning rules have been relaxed for the project to enable it to go ahead as quickly and efficiently as possible.

Once the upgrade to the infrastructure has been completed you can then talk to your Internet

Service Provider (ISP) about upgrading to faster broadband. All ISPs will have access to the new infrastructure.

Although the upgrade in infrastructure is the same everywhere, some areas will still get better broadband speeds than others due to geographical conditions. You should shop around and not simply upgrade to faster broadband with your existing ISP for the best and most effective deal for you.
