Illegal Fishing in Carlton

There have been several reports of illegal fishing, often at night, in the Carlton area, and an increase in reports of people asking where they can fish. On one occasion discarded bait made a local dog very ill - conscientious fishermen throw their unused bait in the river and don't leave it to rot - and on another a man was spotted defecating while fishing.

We have contacted fishing groups and they have indicated the new activity is not down to their members, and is therefore poaching.

You can report suspect fishing to the Environment Agency on 0800 80 70 60 and to the Police (use 999 for ongoing suspected illegal fishing, 101 after the event).

Stop the closure of Newark Custody Suite

There is a move to shut the Custody Suite at Newark Police Station. This would mean police officers would have to travel to and from Mansfield or Nottingham every time they arrested someone in order to process and question them, taking them out of the field for several hours. This will lead to reduced policing levels, wasted man hours or a disinclination to arrest people, and a half empty police station at Newark which will put it at increased risk of closure.
